The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that all people who want to reduce the risk of complication from influenza receive an annual flu vaccine.\*

### Payment Options

- Medicare Part B: No out-of-pocket expense.
- Medicare HMO: No out-of-pocket expense.
- Medicare or Medicare HMO card must be presented during your visit.
- Other/No Insurance: \$25 for flu shots, \$35 for pneumonia shots. Cash or check payment is expected at time of service.
