Samaritan Flight and Ground Transportation Services, two medical helicopters and a Mobile ICU serving northern Indiana and northwest Ohio

Emergency Department, full-service, 24-hour emergency department with 45 treatment rooms including two trauma bays

Surgical Care Center, 17 surgical suites; outpatient surgeries are performed at the hospital and Parkview Eye Surgery Institute

Surgical/Trauma/Neuro Intensive Care Unit, 30-bed unit

Continuing Care Center, 28-bed skilled nursing facility

Family Birthing Center, 8 birthing rooms and 6 postpartum rooms

Regional Children's Center, pediatric unit and pediatric intensive care unit; children's outpatient specialty clinics.

Parkview Heart Institute, cardiac cath labs, inpatient monitored cardiac units, out-patient cardiac rehab, non-invasive testing, participation in worldwide cardiac research studies, PCI-Chest Pain Accreditation, Inpatient Heart Failure Unit & EBT.

Parkview Rehabilitation Center, 31-bed unit, CARF accredited for Comprehensive Inpatient Medical Rehabilitation program, Stroke program and Brain Injury program. Specific staff credentialed as CRRN and as certified brain injury specialists.

Parkview Outpatient Therapy Clinic, OT, PT and Speech Therapy services at three locations.

Parkview Stanley Wissman Stroke Center, clinical research & treatment of stroke.

Parkview Research Center, participation in national and international medical research, bringing the newest technology and medical breakthroughs to the Fort Wayne area.

Parkview Home Health & Hospice, Home care, inpatient palliative care, Home IV services and Hospice care with branch offices in Fort Wayne, Huntington, Columbia City and Kendallville.

Sleep Disorders Center, accredited by the American Academy for Sleep Medicine for the diagnosis and treatment of Sleep-Related Disorders.
