# AVERAGE NUMBER OF THERAPY HOURS


The average number of therapy hours per day for all adult inpatients includes time spent in physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy. In 2023, patients participated in an average of 3.24 hours of therapy each day of a five-day therapy week.

# DISCHARGE TO HOME/COMMUNITY

At Parkview, our goal after completing inpatient rehabilitation is to return home, promoting independence post rehabilitation.

79% of inpatient rehabilitation patients were discharged to their home or the community. The remaining 21% needed additional care at an acute care hospital setting or a skilled nursing facility.





At Parkview, 100% of pediatric patients were discharged to their home or community.

Pediatric average of onset days - 16.8 days


#### **FUNCTIONAL IMPROVEMENT**

100% of patients had functional abilities assessed, functional goals determined and treatment plans developed according to their specific needs.

92% of pediatric patients met or exceeded their mobility goal. 87% of pediatric patients met or exceeded their self-care goal.

# CHANGE IN ABILITY TO CARE FOR THEMSELVES

Patients' self-care scores improved by an average of 10.8 points, which is evaluated at admission and discharge.



# UNPLANNED TRANSFERS FOR ACUTE CARE

A patient may experience changes in their medical condition that would require them to discharge to a medical floor. In 2023, the frequency of these transfers for patients at Parkview Rehabilitation Center was 8.8%.
