SERVICES

- Emergency Department:** full-service, 24-hour emergency department with 13 treatment rooms, trauma room, five other specialized treatment rooms, secure space for patients with mental illness or developmental disabilities, and hazmat shower.
- Surgery Services Department:** 40,000 square feet; four surgical suites for IP/OP, including robotic operating room; 17 private pre/post op rooms; eight bed post anesthesia care unit (PACU) for recovery, including two private rooms; spacious lobbies with amenities for family, including two physician consultation suites.
- Endoscopy:** three endoscopy suites and recovery area.
- Medical Surgical:** 40-bed medical unit.
- Constant Care:** eight-bed constant care unit.
- Outpatient Infusion Therapy Suite:** infusion port placement, access and medication infusions.
- Rehabilitation Services:** inpatient and outpatient physical, occupational, pediatric and speech therapy, cardiac and pulmonary rehab.
- Specialty Clinics:** anticoagulation therapy unit (ATU), pain management, Center for Wound Healing.
- Outpatient Services:** dietitian consultations, cardiopulmonary rehab, EKG, PFT, stress testing, and more.
- Sleep Disorders Lab:** diagnosis and treatment of sleep-related disorders; inpatient and outpatient sleep studies.
- EMS:** Parkview DeKalb Hospital, in partnership with DeKalb County, operates the emergency ambulance services for all areas of DeKalb County.
- Diagnostic Imaging:** 3D mammography, computed tomography (CT) scan, HeartSmart CT scan, LungSmart CT scan, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), bone density exam (DEXA), nuclear medicine to include cardiology, echocardiogram (ECHO), ultrasound, fluoroscopy, and diagnostic X-ray.



- Laboratory:** accredited, full-service, comprehensive inpatient and outpatient lab services.
- Occupational Health:** drug testing, including DOT regulated and nonregulated, such as rapid hair testing; physical exams postoffer/preplacement, workability/fit for duty, DOT, executive physicals; medical surveillance screenings, including audiograms, vision, respirator surveillance, vaccination/titers, and OSHA mandated surveillance programs.
- Parkview Physicians Group:** primary care services on the hospital campus. Other specialties on campus include asthma, allergy, general surgery, immunology, cardiology, pulmonology, obstetrics, gynecology, urology, pediatrics, orthopedics, podiatry, pain management, colon and rectal surgery, rheumatology, infectious disease, neurology, and sleep medicine services.
- Walk-in Clinic:** open daily, providing treatment for a wide range of minor, nonemergency health concerns, including respiratory, infections, minor burns, illness, fever, nausea, and cold/flu.
- Retail Pharmacy:** full-service retail pharmacy featuring over-the-counter items, vitamins and natural supplements, orthopedic supports, and breastfeeding supplies. Prescription compounding and customized medications, medication packaging, e-prescriptions, and free prescription delivery. Two locations in Auburn and Garrett.
- Alliance Health Centers:** provides quality primary medical, OB/GYN, pediatric, and behavioral health care for people of all ages. Focused on your health, we believe everyone deserves the best care possible, regardless of ability to pay. That's why we offer a sliding fee scale discount available to those who qualify.*
