Founded: First hospital established in 1950; current facility opened in 2008

Organizational Structure: Charitable, not-for-profit, community-owned hospital; Member of Parkview Health since 2005; critical access hospital status

Size/Campus: 95,238-square-foot facility, including an attached medical office plaza, sitting on a 13-acre campus; a half-mile paved walking track, outdoor exercise equipment, and sheltered long- and short-term horse-and-buggy parking are also available on campus

Beds: 25

Medical Staff Members: 333 active and affiliate physicians, 85 allied health professionals



SERVICES

- **Emergency Department:** full-service, 24-hour emergency department with eight treatment rooms, in addition to a trauma room and a triage room
- **Surgery:** two surgery suites and two endoscopy suites; surgical services include general surgeries, laparoscopic and endoscopic procedures, podiatry, and orthopedic procedures, including total joint replacements
- **Ambulatory Services:** outpatient surgery, infusion therapy, anticoagulation therapy, and more
- **Rehabilitation Services:** inpatient and outpatient physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech pathology, and cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation
- **Diagnostic Imaging:** MRI, CT scan, echocardiogram, ultrasound, digital mammography, nuclear medicine, fluoroscopy, DEXA bone-density scan, SmartLung CT scan, HeartSmart CT scan
- **Occupational Health Services:** off-site health services to local businesses and industries
- **LifeBridge Senior Program:** outpatient behavioral health program for seniors
- **EMS:** Parkview operates the emergency paramedic center service for the LaGrange County area; includes interhospital transfers
- **Specialty Medical Services:** cardiology, colon and rectal surgery, general surgery, ophthalmology, orthopedics, pain management, podiatry, pulmonary, and urology
- **Parkview Physicians Group:** primary care services on the hospital campus and in several locations in LaGrange County
- **Specialized Inpatient Care:** medical/surgical care, hospice rooms, medical detox, and transitional skilled nursing care through the Continuing Care Program
- **Hospice:** dedicated hospice rooms designed to provide supportive care to hospice patients



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
