Conveniently located along I-69 on Fort Wayne's north side, the Parkview Regional Medical Center (PRMC) is our investment in improving regional access to quality healthcare for generations to come. More than a hospital, PRMC is an entire campus for health and wellness. The nine-story main building includes a 238-bed hospital with all-private rooms. Several specialty centers are also on campus. Technology is a key component of the state-of-the-art medical center, improving safety for patients and efficiency for staff.

PRMC is a destination of healing, with low noise and light levels; calming influences of stone, water, natural light, and other elements of nature; and outdoor spaces for dining and socializing. Families with children can unleash their energies in the wide-open space of the park.

Parkview Packnett Family Cancer Institute is a state-of-the-art facility that incorporates a healing environment through the use of natural lighting, private spaces for families, respite rooms and more. This physician-led facility uses an enhanced nurse navigator system that allows for coordinated care throughout a patient's cancer journey. The institute offers infusion, radiation oncology, and other outpatient services, such as the region's only Cyberknife®, technology that destroys tumors in difficult-to-reach areas.

Parkview Outpatient Center includes radiology, lab, preadmission testing, EKG, Premier Surgery Center, and physician offices.

Parkview Women's & Children's Hospital includes a newly-renovated 40-bed Family Birthing Center that includes 16 labor and delivery rooms, four triage bays, two operating rooms, 24 postpartum rooms, and an 8-bed newborn nursery. For the littlest patients who need extra care, the Neonatal ICU has also been recently renovated and expanded. The Pediatric unit has 27 private rooms to make the stay for young patients as comfortable as possible.

Parkview Heart Institute, the region's only dedicated heart hospital and an alliance of the Cleveland Clinic Heart, Vascular & Thoracic Institute, is dedicated to the prevention, awareness, detection, and treatment of heart disease. Physicians, advanced-practice providers, nurses, and co-workers within the 82-bed facility—also a certified comprehensive stroke center—deliver specialized cardiac intensive care, acute care, and support programs such as heart failure, AFib, and electrophysiology. Thirteen outpatient specialty clinics support patients with standardized, protocol-driven care by a collaborative team dedicated to treating their condition. Parkview Heart Institute advances its specialty care format further by embedding continuity of care plans, population management schemes, disease-based quality outcome data, and new care-integration models into every patient visit.

Medical Parks 2, 3, 4 and 11 house a variety of physicians' offices, outpatient services, and wellness resources.
