MAJOR SERVICES

- Emergency Department:** full-service, 24-hour emergency department with 44 treatment rooms, including one trauma bay
- Intensive Care Unit:** 12 state-of-the-art beds supported by intensivist services
- Surgical Care Center:** 10 surgical suites for inpatient and outpatient surgeries, including robotic surgery, eye surgery, and endoscopy
- Family Birthing Center:** 10 labor/delivery/recovery/postpartum rooms; 3 triage rooms; newborn nursery; birth planner services; birthing tubs available; lactation consultant and support; and WIC assistance on-site
- Parkview Rehabilitation Center:** 50-bed unit, CARF-accredited for comprehensive inpatient medical rehabilitation, stroke and brain injury programs; CRRN staff and certified brain injury specialists; and activities of daily living (ADL) suite
- Parkview Outpatient Therapy:** comprehensive physical, occupational, and speech therapy tailored to individuals recovering from orthopedic and neurologic conditions such as amputations, stroke, traumatic brain injury, sensitive compartmented information, concussion, vestibular disorders, and Parkinson's disease
- Parkview Center for Wound Healing:** 3,000 square-foot center includes two fully private, glass-enclosed hyperbaric chambers and four exam rooms where the latest approaches in wound care and hyperbaric medicine are practiced
- Outpatient Infusion Center:** three private infusion suites with capacity for 12 patients to receive hydration, antibiotics, or other infusion medications
- Palliative Care:** comfort, support, and medical management for patients with serious or life-limiting illnesses in the hospital or at outpatient clinic on the north campus after discharge
- Parkview Hospice:** holistic, personalized care for individuals with a terminal illness who wish to focus on comfort and quality of life
- Parkview Health at Home:** short-term home health for patients who are chronically ill or recovering from a recent illness; skilled nursing visits, home health aides, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy



- Parkview Home Infusion:** infusion medications, enteral nutrition, and services for patients in their homes or in clinic
- Acute Inpatient Units:** cardiology, general surgery, gastroenterology, palliative care, infectious disease, interventional radiology, nephrology, neurology, ophthalmology, podiatry, pulmonology, psychiatry, urology; on-site hospitalist physician services 24 hours/day
- Community Nursing:** Parkview registered nurses offer a variety of health-related services and education in local schools and throughout surrounding communities.
- Parkview Community Greenhouse & Learning Kitchen:** provides greater access to fresh, affordable produce and engages our community with opportunities to learn new skills at home—in the kitchen and the garden
- Parkview Health Graduate Medical Education:** Graduate Medical Education is located at Parkview Hospital Randallia and offers resident physicians the opportunity to rotate through 12 facilities in northeast Indiana. The Parkview Residency Center is a state-of-the-art facility that includes family medicine, general surgery, internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, physical medicine and rehabilitation, psychiatry, and transitional year, offering patients the opportunity to have a resident physician as part of their care team.
