Founded: First hospital established in 1950; current facility opened in 2008

Organizational Structure: Charitable, not-for-profit, community-owned hospital; Member of Parkview Health since 2005; Critical access hospital status

Size/Campus: 95,238-square-foot facility, including an attached medical office plaza, sitting on a 13-acre campus; a ½ mile paved walking track, outdoor exercise equipment and sheltered long and short term horse and buggy parking are also available on campus

Beds: 25

Medical Staff Members: 329 active and affiliate physicians, 51 allied health professionals

SERVICES

Emergency Department: full-service, 24-hour emergency department with eight treatment rooms, in addition to a trauma room and a triage room

Critical Care Unit: critical care unit with eICU technology

Surgery: surgical services include general surgeries, gynecologic procedures, laparoscopic and endoscopic procedures, and orthopedic procedures including total joint replacements

Ambulatory Services: outpatient surgery, infusion therapy, anticoagulation therapy and more

Family Birthing Center: labor and delivery rooms, post-partum rooms, and a neonatal procedure room; birth planner and lactation consulting services available

Rehabilitation Services: inpatient and outpatient physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech pathology

Sleep Disorders Lab: diagnosis and treatment of sleep-related disorders, over-night and home-based sleep studies available

Diagnostic Imaging: MRI, CT scan, echocardiogram, ultrasound, digital mammography, nuclear medicine, fluoroscopy, DEXA bone density scan, SmartLung CT scan, HeartSmart CT scan



Occupational Health Services: healthcare services to local businesses and industries

LifeBridge Senior Program: outpatient behavioral health program for seniors

EMS: Parkview LaGrange Hospital operates the emergency paramedic service for the LaGrange County area; includes inter-hospital transfers

Specialty Medical Services: cardiology, colon and rectal surgery, general surgery, obstetrics/gynecology, certified nurse midwife, oncology, ophthalmology, orthopedics, podiatry and urology

Parkview Physicians Group: primary care services on the hospital campus and in several locations in LaGrange County

Inpatient: Medical/surgical care, constant care unit, and transitional skilled nursing care through the Swing Bed Program
