MAJOR SERVICES

Emergency Department: full-service, 24-hour emergency department with 44 treatment rooms, including two trauma bays, and Level 3 Bronze Geriatric Accreditation

Intensive Care Unit: 12 state-of-the-art beds equipped with telemedicine connections to intensivist services

Surgical Care Center: 10 surgical suites for inpatient and outpatient surgeries, including eye surgeries and endoscopy

Family Birthing Center: 10 labor/delivery/recovery/postpartum rooms; 1 tub room for labor pain management; 3 triage rooms; newborn nursery; birth planner services; lactation consultant and support; and WIC assistance on site

Parkview Rehabilitation Center: 50-bed unit, CARF-accredited for Comprehensive Inpatient Medical Rehabilitation, Stroke and Brain Injury programs; CRRN staff and certified brain injury specialists; and Activities of Daily Living (ADL) suite

Parkview Outpatient Therapy: occupational, physical and speech therapy services

Parkview Center for Wound Healing: 3,000 square-foot center includes two fully private, glass-enclosed hyperbaric chambers and four exam rooms, where the latest approaches in wound care and hyperbaric medicine are practiced

Outpatient Infusion Center: private infusion suites with capacity for 12 patients to receive hydration, antibiotics or other infusion medications



Parkview Home Health & Hospice: home care, inpatient palliative care, home IV infusion services and hospice care (with branch offices in Fort Wayne, Huntington, Columbia City, Kendallville and Wabash)

Sleep Disorders Center: eight-bed center, accredited by the American Academy of Sleep Medicine for the diagnosis and treatment of sleep-related disorders, that performs sleep studies for adults and children

Parkview Behavioral Health Institute: 89-bed, free-standing facility with an acute care psychiatric hospital, providing inpatient services to children, adolescents, adults and older individuals. PBHI also provides chemical dependency and psychiatric intensive outpatient services for adults. Parkview BridgeWays, a 20-bed inpatient facility serving geriatric patients, is located inside Parkview Hospital Randallia.

Community Nursing: Parkview registered nurses offer a variety of health-related services and education in local schools and throughout surrounding communities.

Parkview Community Greenhouse & Learning Kitchen: provides greater access to fresh, affordable produce and engages our community with opportunities to learn new skills at home—in the kitchen and the garden.
