

Parkview Family Park



Opened in 2009, the Parkview Family Park is a fully accessible, thoughtfully designed recreation area, perfect for family outings. Located on the Parkview Regional Medical Center campus, the 26.5-acre park offers visitors plenty of space to relax and enjoy themselves.

The public is invited to use this Parkview-owned and operated facility free of charge. We ask that visitors be considerate, observe the rules and safety guidelines and leave the area tidy for others.*

Hours

Open daily (seasonally) from dawn to dusk. (Pavilion restrooms are open April – October, depending on weather.)

Features

- Fully handicap-accessible playground with cushioned surface
- Picnic shelters and gazebos
- Large covered pavilion with restrooms
- Scenic pond with fountain
- Paved walking trail
- Fitness equipment area (for visitors 16 and older)
- Amphitheater with stage
- Free, lighted parking with paved walkway into park

Guidelines for park use

Use of the pavilion and amphitheater is restricted to Parkview Health staff and community groups that have requested permission from Parkview administration. Neither park feature can be reserved; both are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

No organized events may be held in the park unless specifically sponsored by Parkview. No signs or banners promoting events may be posted unless approved by Parkview administration.

Playground

- Exercise common sense and use equipment at your own risk.
- Avoid using playground equipment when wet or during non-daylight hours.
- Supervise children at all times. Parents/guardians are responsible for the safety of children in their care.
- Use age-appropriate play equipment correctly:
 - Never climb up slides. Slide down in a seated position.
 - Never climb over barriers, safety rails or horizontal ladders.
 - Use handholds provided on climbing equipment.

Park area

- Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult and supervised. Pets must be on a leash.
- Park vehicles only in designated areas.
- All litter must be placed in trash containers.
- No signs may be posted or displayed.

Prohibited activities

- Bicycling, skateboarding or skating
- Use of moonwalks or inflatable attractions
- Tobacco, alcohol or drug use
- Open fires and grilling
- Swimming, boating, ice skating or fishing
- Profanity, loud music or disruptive behavior
- Use of fireworks or firearms
- Removal of park property

Rude or destructive behavior or any activity that jeopardizes the safety and well-being of others is NOT allowed.

To report prohibited – especially dangerous – activities observed at the park, call (260) 266-1800 or 266-1801.

* Parkview reserves the right to refuse admittance or to require any individual or group to leave the park for violating park guidelines, or for failing to seek appropriate authorization in advance of planned events.
