Founded: First hospital established in 1919; current facility opened in 2018

Organizational Structure: Charitable, not-for-profit, community-owned hospital; member of Parkview Health since January 1, 2015

Size/Campus: The campus includes a two-story, 82,000-square-foot hospital and a 31,000-square-foot medical office building, home to Parkview Physicians Group offices and services. The hospital features a user-friendly design, with several public areas and services on the first floor, including: lab, radiology, emergency department, pulmonary testing, chapel, café and gift shop. The second floor houses inpatient services, including: medical/surgical, constant care unit, pharmacy and Family Birthing Center.

Medical Staff Members: 246 affiliate physicians; 57 advanced practice providers

SERVICES

Emergency Department: staffed 24 hours a day, 365 days a year by board-certified physicians and registered nurses who are trained in emergency medicine and care. Includes nine patient care rooms plus a triage room. The patient care rooms include a trauma room and a “safe room” for patients who may be experiencing a behavioral health crisis.

Surgery: two surgical suites and six private pre-/post-op rooms. Surgical services include general surgery, urology, endoscopy, ENT, gynecology, orthopedics and colorectal. Laparoscopic and endoscopic procedures performed, and 24-hour coverage provided.

Medical/Surgical/CCU: 16 inpatient rooms are equipped with “smart beds” that communicate with the patient, as well as touch-screen vital sign monitors. Each room also has a central monitoring system. Physicians can monitor patient vital signs remotely, access health chart information, speak with the patients, and provide diagnoses.

Rehabilitation Services: cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation provided. Inpatient and swing bed rehabilitation includes physical, occupational and speech therapy. Outpatient physical, occupational and speech therapy; aquatic rehab; wound care; women’s health therapy; and sports medicine are available at The Rehab Place of Parkview Wabash Hospital, located at the Wabash County YMCA.

ATU Walk-in Clinic: assists warfarin patients and monitors blood-thinner medication dosing.



Outpatient Infusion: serves ambulatory patients who need intravenous chemotherapy, intravenous hydration and blood transfusions.

Diagnostic Services: offers a wide range of outpatient services, from advanced diagnostic imaging — including CT, MRI and nuclear medicine — plus cardiac monitoring, pulmonary function testing, vascular and HeartSmart screening, to an imaging center with 3D mammography, bone density scanning and ultrasound. Full-service laboratory.

Family Birthing Center: features two private suites for labor, delivery, recovery and postpartum care; advanced fetal monitoring and surveillance; and breastfeeding support for moms.

Physician Specialty Clinics: cardiology, colorectal, dermatology, ENT, nephrology, neurology, pain management, obstetrics and gynecology, oncology, orthopedics, psychiatry, podiatry, pulmonology, sports medicine and urology.

Sleep Center: on-site diagnosis and treatment of sleep-related disorders. Generous room amenities offered for patient comfort during overnight sleep studies. Home sleep studies are also available.

LifeBridge Senior Program: intensive outpatient behavioral health program for seniors, offering medication management and group and individual therapy.

Parkview Home Health and Hospice: IV therapy, pain control, ostomy/catheter care, wound care, cardiac/respiratory care, support services, rehab therapies, grief support group and pain/symptom control.

Parkview Wabash Foundation: fundraising entity for Parkview Wabash Hospital.
