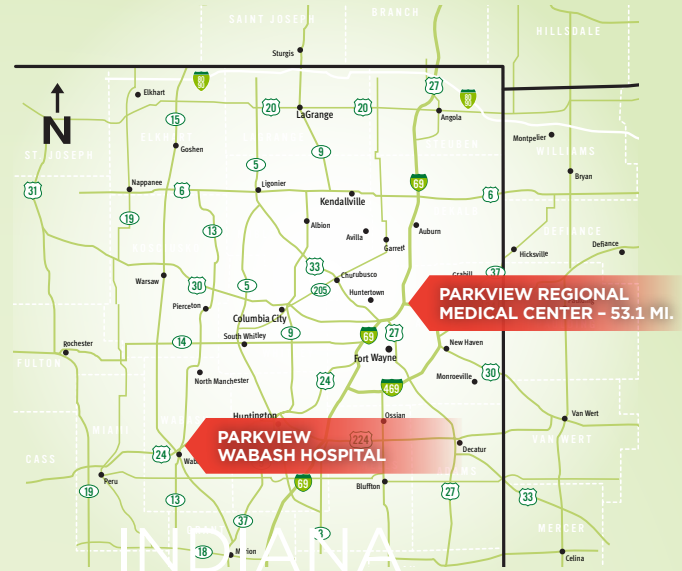
Founded: First hospital established in 1919; current facility opened in 2018

Organizational Structure: Charitable, not-for-profit, community-owned hospital; member of Parkview Health since January 1, 2015

Size/Campus: The campus includes a two-story, 82,000-square-foot hospital and a 31,000-square-foot medical office building, home to Parkview Physicians Group offices and services. The hospital features a user-friendly design and includes an on-site pharmacy, chapel, cafe and gift shop.

Medical Staff Members: 288 active and affiliate physicians; 62 advanced practice providers



SERVICES

Emergency Department: staffed 24 hours a day, 365 days a year by board-certified physicians and registered nurses who are trained in emergency medicine and care. Includes nine patient care rooms plus a triage room. The patient care rooms include a trauma room and a “safe room” for patients who may be experiencing a behavioral health crisis.

Surgery: two surgical suites and six private pre-/post-op rooms. Surgical services include general surgery, urology, endoscopy, ENT, gynecology, orthopedics and colorectal. Laparoscopic and endoscopic procedures performed, and 24-hour coverage provided.

Medical/Surgical/CCU: 16 inpatient rooms equipped with “smart beds” and a central monitoring system. Physicians can speak with and monitor patients remotely, access chart information and provide diagnoses.

Rehabilitation Services: cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation provided. Inpatient and swing bed rehabilitation includes physical, occupational and speech therapy. Outpatient physical, occupational and speech therapy; aquatic rehab; wound care; women’s health therapy; and sports medicine are available at The Rehab Place of Parkview Wabash Hospital, located at the Wabash County YMCA.

ATU Walk-in Clinic: assists warfarin patients and monitors blood-thinner medication dosing.

Outpatient Infusion: serves ambulatory patients who need intravenous chemotherapy, intravenous hydration and blood transfusions.

Diagnostic Services: offers a wide range of outpatient services, from advanced diagnostic imaging — including CT, MRI and nuclear medicine — plus cardiac monitoring, pulmonary function testing, vascular and HeartSmart screening, to an imaging center with 3D mammography, bone density scanning and ultrasound. Full-service laboratory.

Family Birthing Center: features two private suites for labor, delivery, recovery and postpartum care; advanced fetal monitoring and surveillance; and breastfeeding support for moms.

Physician Specialty Clinics: cardiology, colorectal, dermatology, ENT, nephrology, neurology, pain management, obstetrics and gynecology, oncology, orthopedics, psychiatry, podiatry, pulmonology, sports medicine and urology.

Sleep Center: on-site diagnosis and treatment of sleep-related disorders. Generous room amenities offered for patient comfort during overnight sleep studies. Home sleep studies are also available.

Behavioral Health Services: offers outpatient alcohol and opioid dependency medication treatment. Intensive outpatient group treatment offers three phases of group sessions for treatment, enabling patients to engage in daily routines and continue living at home. LifeBridge Intensive Outpatient Program for seniors offers medical management and group/individual therapy for individuals over 65.
