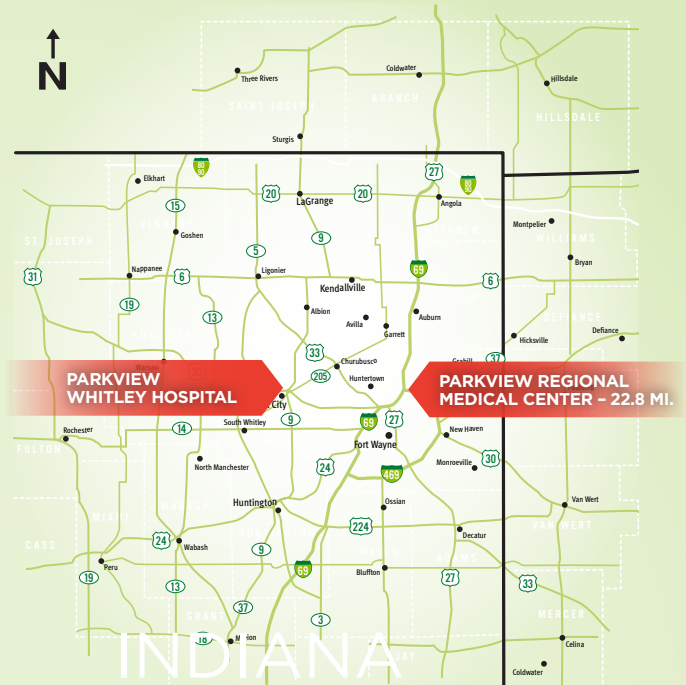
Founded: First hospital established in 1951; current hospital opened in 2011

Organizational Structure: Charitable, not-for-profit, community-owned hospital; Member of Parkview Health since 1995

Size/Campus: 155,500-total-square-foot facility (including attached medical plaza and ambulance buildings); sitting on 42 partially wooded acres

SERVICES

Emergency Department: full-service, 24-hour emergency department, eight emergency exam rooms and two private trauma rooms

Critical Care Center: four-bed critical care unit with eICU technology

Surgery: three large surgical suites with state-of-the-art equipment, including daVinci minimally-invasive robotic technology

Family Birthing Center: five private labor/delivery/recovery and postpartum rooms

Rehabilitation Services: physical therapy, occupational therapy, cardiac and pulmonary rehab, all in the attached Medical Office Building

Sleep Disorders Lab: diagnosis and treatment of sleep-related disorders

Diagnostic Imaging: state-of-the-art equipment in CT, nuclear medicine, ultrasound, fluoroscopy and bone density, plus MRI, digital mammography, HeartSmart CT scan and routine radiology available

EMS: Parkview Whitley Hospital provides emergency medical services in Columbia City, Churubusco and South Whitley

Parkview Physicians Group: primary care services on the hospital campus and in several locations in Whitley County

Outpatient Lab Services: in-house testing of coagulation, urinalysis, hematology, blood gas and chemistry tests; certified clinical laboratory scientists on staff 24-hours per day
